**FRIDAY, MAY 29, 2026: DEPART USA** Today you begin a wondrous adventure as you depart the USA on an overnight flight to Copenhagen, Denmark. Meals and refreshments served on board.

**DAY 1 SATURDAY, MAY 30, 2026: ARRIVE COPENHAGEN, DENMARK** Welcome to Copenhagen. Not only is it the trendiest city of Scandinavia, but it also gets constantly ranked as the happiest city in the world. Upon arrival, you will be met at the airport by your Tour Director and transferred to a hotel in the city center. After checking in, Classic Canal cruise. Tivoli Gardens is an amusement park in Copenhagen that is a must for all visitors to the city. It was founded in 1843 and has become a national treasure and an international attraction. Fairytale writer Hans Christian Andersen visited many times, as did Walt Disney and many other celebrities, who all fell in love with the gardens. Overnight in Copenhagen. Tonight enjoy a welcome dinner in Tivoli Gardens. (WD)

**DAY 2 SUNDAY, MAY 31, 2026: COPENHAGEN, PANORAMIC CITY TOUR** This morning, following breakfast, you head out on a guided panoramic city tour of Copenhagen. Enjoy the famed charms from the past and present, including the infamous Little Mermaid and the Rococo Royal Palace Amalienborg. Walk around Nyhavn, originally a busy commercial port, but nowadays a vibrant hub of city life and shopping. Don't forget to notice the house, which was home to the famous writer Christian Andersen. Next, as part of our Cultural Discovery Series – visit The Royal Reception Rooms -Christiansborg Palace. Overnight in Copenhagen. (B)

**DAY 3 MONDAY, JUN 01, 2026: COPENHAGEN TO OSLO - DFDS** After breakfast at your hotel and checking out, you will visit Rosenborg Castle, which hosts an important collection of the Danish crown jewels and Carlsberg Glyptotek - Ny Carlsberg Glyptotek with its Egyptian and Greek collections but also several rooms dedicated to French impressionists including one dedicated to Gauguin's work. You'll remember that he maintained a close relationship with painter Willumsen, which enabled Danish people to discover the man who started modern art. Time permitting, enjoy the rest of the day before embarkation at leisure to shop for Viking souvenirs, this afternoon you will be transferred to the DFDS Seaways terminal for your ferry ride to Oslo, departing early evening. Enjoy your first Scandinavian smorgasbord dinner as you cruise gently up the Kattegat. Kattegat is a narrow bay in southern Scandinavia. From the Oresund and Danish Straits, the Kattegat takes the waters of the Baltic Sea to the Skagerrak, which connects to the North Sea. Dinner and overnight on board. (B, D)



**DAY 4 TUESDAY, JUN 2, 2026: OSLO, NORWAY - CITY TOUR** A delicious buffet breakfast on board will be served as you cruise along the enchanting Oslo Fjord. Welcome to the Kingdom of Norway – a country with the most beautiful fjords on Earth. Upon arrival, you will board your coach and head out on a guided tour of the Norwegian capital, including the impressive Royal Palace, the main Karl Joan’s district, and the Vigeland Sculpture Park. Norske folk museum. Visit one of the biggest outdoor museums in Europe where you’ll discover several traditional houses from different regions of Norway. This museum hosts 150 authentic buildings, especially one of Norway’s oldest constructions: a wooden church from the 12th century. Inside traditional art, period costumes and ancient toys are exhibited while outside folkloric dance shows are held. Overnight at the hotel. (B)

**DAY 5 WEDNESDAY, JUN 3, 2026: OSLO TO STOCKHOLM BY TRAIN** After breakfast you head for the station to board the train to Stockholm. Relaxing from the comfort of your seat you will see spectacular scenery, a fairyland of wooden houses, rolling green hills, small towns and villages before you arrive in Stockholm. Here you will check into your hotel and relax. The rest of the day at leisure. (B)

**DAY 6 THURSDAY, JUN 4, 2026: STOCKHOLM, SWEDEN - CITY TOUR** After breakfast, enjoy a guided tour of Stockholm. Famous sights on the tour include the Royal Palace, the Parliament Buildings, the island of Djurgarden and the Old Town (Gamla Stan), with its narrow-cobbled streets and numerous antique shops. The highlight of the tour is a visit to the City Hall with its famous Blue and Golden Rooms, where the Nobel Prize Banquet is held each year. As part of our Cultural Discovery Series - sample local delicacies in one of Stockholm’s trendiest restaurants and learn about the Nordic food and culture. Continue your walk through the Södermalm neighborhood and experience a multicultural mix of chic restaurants and shops. Enjoy your afternoon at leisure or take an optional tour to the impressive Skansen Park and Vasa Museum. Visit Skansen Park, an outdoor museum which explores the Scandinavian housing evolution. Built in 1891, it’s the oldest museum of this kind in the world, with 150 houses, bungalows, churches, farms and manors coming from all over Sweden and brought to life by staff in period costume. One can also find the reconstitution of a Lapp village. Continue to visit the Vasa Museum to see the Vasa ship which was built in 1628 and sank during its launch in Stockholm Harbor. Refloating in 1961, he was remarkably refurbished and gives a great vision of naval life in the 17th century. The seven-floor museum enables you to admire this unique ship from every angle. Tonight, you will enjoy a farewell dinner at the local restaurant. (B, D)

**DAY 7 FRIDAY, JUN 5 , 2026: DEPART STOCKHOLM** Today after breakfast you will be transferred to Stockholm International Airport for your return flight home. (B)
